Must be willing to accept the call of self-sacrifice in meeting the needs of a dynamic and growing music ministry. The position entails administrative and musical responsibilities.

Main Responsibilities:

- Serve as the chief assisting musician via piano or organ. Must be an accomplished musician with a sensitivity to the nuances of Spirit-led worship.
- Assist in the creative planning of music for Sunday, midweek, Easter/Christmas cantata, and other routine and special services.
- Assist in the teaching of musical selections to choir, developing choir's vocal production and musicology, and in general, shaping the choir's sound to fit varying genres as needed.
- Assist in the conducting of ensembles including Praise Team, Men's Chorus, Young Adult choir, etc.
- Assist in recruiting, equipping, motivating, and shepherding of choir members, especially the Young Adult Choir.
- Maintain a ministry of encouragement to all who offer themselves in the various forms of the worship or in support of our worship services.
- Assist in identifying and the cultivating the call and commitment of individuals seeking to serve the church through the worship arts.
- Assist in the administrative components of service execution, including routine communications to choir members, scheduling practices, corralling musicians, and other general administrative functions.

Secondary Responsibilities:

- Assume primary worship planning responsibility in filling in for the Minister of Music as needed.
- Assist in the planning of special and outreach events.
- Build a bereavement choir.
- Incorporate the arts into our worship services where appropriate, by stimulating and encouraging drama, dance and visual arts personnel.
- Identify, encourage and integrate worshipers' musical gifts into worship and special event services.
- Assist in developing and planning major, festive worship events.

- Assist in planning, as desired, various worship arts events or special services that may fulfill our vision (Praise Night, Jazz event, Holy Week devotions, etc.)
- Participate in the life and ministry of the church.
- Misc. duties as needed.

- Must have an authentic, growing relationship with God in Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord
- Possess a vibrant vision for worship and the ability to express that vision.
- Proficient in piano or organ across a variety of genres including gospel, contemporary, traditional, sacred, and classical idioms.
