A Love Note From Pastor



It's March! Spring is at our doorsteps. The long bleak Winter is coming to an end. With Spring, comes Spring cleaning. Time to clean house and do all the things that say that we are ready for new life. This is the essence of Lent. Lent gives us a chance to clean house; the opportunity to rid ourselves of the things that crowd Christ out of life.

Lent is a 40-day period that begins on Ash Wednesday and extends through Holy Saturday, the day before Resurrection Sunday (Easter). The six Sundays that occur during Lent are not counted among the 40 days. The last week of Lent, Holy or Passion Week, includes Maundy Thursday and Good Friday. Maundy Thursday (also referred to as Holy Thursday) commemorates the Last Supper, during which Jesus shared the Passover Meal with his disciples; this took place the night before Jesus was crucified. Given the focus of this liturgical moment, it is extremely important to recall what Jesus did after the Meal. He washed the feet of his disciples (John 13:5), demonstrating how Christians are to love one another in humility and through service.

While Lent has evolved into a season during which we give something up, let us strive to be authentic disciples of Jesus Christ by also putting something positive in place. During this Lenten season, let's make a collective commitment to leave our comfort zones and reach out and touch someone in need, take a stand for justice, show hospitality to people we don't know, help the poor, visit the sick, or visit someone in prison whom we do not know. Oh, how powerful the Church will be if we do this during the Lenten season and throughout the year! Each of us has the capacity to do great things for Christ by serving others! We have the capacity to spread the Good News of Christ in word and in deed.

AS PASTOR, I CALL SHILOH TO A LENTEN FAST. This will be a fast like none other. During this Season of Lent, I call each member of our family to fast from unwholesome and negative speech. THIS WILL BE 40 DAYS OF LENTEN LOVE LANGUAGE. Pray about your language and tone throughout this Lenten season. Refrain from talk that does not lift and encourage one another. Go out of your way to say things that will build each other up. Pray to pose all that you say in positive language, and if you cannot say it positively, don't say it! When you go out, say wonderful things about your church, it's ministries and members.




