



### **Verse**

Both Mahlon and Kilion also died, and Naomi was left without her two sons and her husband. Ruth 1:5 NIV.

### **Thought**

My father died when he was 47 years old. He had not been sick, but he did have to undergo tests that required minor surgery. Unfortunately, he was given more anesthesia than his heart could handle, and he died of a heart attack in the hospital. My mother was 44 years old and had never lived independently. She got married to my father at 19 years and moved from her mother's house to my father's. It was a devastating loss for our entire family.

Thank God my father had life insurance and mortgage insurance. When he died, all of his major bills were paid because he was well insured. He also had all of his business organized in a way that made handling his affairs after his death quite easy. In fact, a week before he died, he took me to his bank and showed me the contents of his safe deposit box, which is where he kept all of his important papers. There was a note in that box detailing the exact steps I should take when he died - names, phone numbers and the information to be discussed with the person named. A week later, when my father died, I went back to the bank, retrieved the papers and followed the written instructions.

A few years ago, when I was diagnosed with cancer, I did the exact same thing with my sons that my dad had done with me. It doesn't make much sense to work a lifetime, accumulate assets and leave loved ones and family in disarray when life comes to an end. Things happen.

Naomi lost her husband and her two sons. This left three women widowed with still a lot of living remaining for them to do. Enjoying success in life must include preparing for the end of life. Failing to do so is to live in denial and to undo whatever success you have achieved.
